CRESCENT LOG RACK

Made from quarter-inch carbon steel, this firewood rack is finished with an iron oxide patina that darkens with age or an optional high-temperature paint. The elegant curve measures 39 inches by 21 inches high and can be used for a heavy-duty load. ●
