

## <u>Automatic Safety Shut-Off System</u> Installing Replacement Thermocouple

NOTE: It is always recommended that a licensed plumber installs the Gas Lantern and replacement parts

NOTE: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN BRASS

- Step 1: Turn gas off inside the light and at the main line or the external shut off valve if so equipped.
- **Step 2**: Remove the old thermocouple from the back of the safety valve with a 5/16 wrench.
- **Step 3**: Screw in the new thermocouple and lightly tighten. Do not over-tighten.
- **Step 4**: Follow the separate "Initial Set-Up" instructions to correctly position the thermocouple flame sensor and relight the fixture.

NOTE: If the flame sensor is constantly inside the flame, this will shorten the life expectancy of the thermocouple.
